Capernaum: Peter's House



Since 1990, the feast of Saints Peter and Paul (June 29) has been celebrated with special devotion in the modern church built over Peter's house in Capernaum, by the Sea of Galilee. Jesus' "Bread of Life" discourse (Jn 6:22-59) was given in the city's synagogue. The current synagogue ruins, the oldest and best preserved ones in Israel, date to the fifth century AD, but they rest atop an earlier synagogue.

In 1894, Franciscan friars bought the unused land containing the synagogue, which was excavated by Friars Wendelin von Menden and Gaudenzio Orfali. Over the course of 19 summers, Friars Virgilio Corbo and Stanislao Loffreda of Jerusalem's *Studium Biblicum Franciscanum* excavated the "House of Peter". That structure is under a fifth-century octagonal church built over an earlier church incorporating a first century octagonal house-obviously an important spot for early Christians.

The modern octagonal church contains a central open area allowing visitors to see the fifth-century church and earlier nearby buildings. Maps, documentation, and a virtual tour can be accessed through the "Sanctuaries" link at www.custodia.org. Pope Paul VI visited Capernaum in 1964; St. John Paul II went there in 2000.

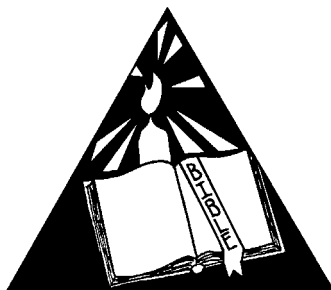
All Adults welcome! Holy Redeemer is offering two new opportunities to join us beginning in Fall 2014 on Monday Evenings 7-9 pm.

Blessed Among Us

Bernard Haring Theologian (1912-1998)

Bernard Haring, a German Redemptorist priest, was disappointed when his superiors sent him to study moral theology, a topic he found a "crushing bore". Over many centuries moral theology had become an intricate system of laws and prohibitions, a catalog of venial and mortal sins. Yet after earning his doctorate at Tübingen, Haring would fundamentally transform the field. Drawing on Scripture and personalist philosophy, Haring recast the moral life as a dynamic between God's invitation and the free choice of human beings to respond in love.

During the war he served as a medic in the German army. The experience of totalitarianism affected his later theology convincing him that moral teaching must not rest on blind obedience but on the courage to be responsible. In 1954 he published his landmark work, *The Law of Christ*. He went on to serve as a key theological expert at Vatican II and spent the rest of his life promoting and defending the spirit of the Council. At the same time, he believed it "laughable" that most moral theology focused on sexual themes. "My main calling," He said, "must be that of an untiring apostle for the elimination of war... for a radical love that will not allow us to become enemies." Haring died on July 3, 1998.

"God speaks in many ways to awaken, deepen and strengthen faith, hope, love and the spirit of adoration. We are believers to the extent that, in all of reality and in all events that touch us, we perceive a gift and a call from God."—Bernard Haring
