### Blessed Among Us Agnes McLaren Missionary Doctor (1837-1913)

Agnes McLaren, who was born to a Presbyterian family in Edinburgh, was only the tenth woman in Britain to graduate as a doctor. She considered it a religious calling: "Is not medicine one of the best means of helping suffering humanity?" she wrote. "Yes, Christ is the supreme physician." Yet even as she practiced medicine, she felt called to grow closer to God. Her religious search concluded in 1898 with her reception in the Catholic Church. Two years later she became a Third Order Dominican.

At the age of seventy-two, McLaren traveled to India, where she established and funded a hospital in Rawalpindi. She was particularly moved by the plight of women, who, for cultural restrictions, were unable to be examined by male physicians and were thus deprived of medical care. This inspired her vision of a missionary order of doctor-sisters. She failed to find an existing congregation interested in this plan. Nor, despite several trips to Rome, could she win approval for such an innovation in the rules of religious life.

In early 1913 McLaren fell ill and died on April 17. She did not live to see the realization of her dream. And yet she had planted seeds. In 1920 Dr. Anna Dengel, who had corresponded with McLaren and had been inspired by her example to study medicine, took charge of the hospital she had founded in India. She went on to establish the Society of Catholic Medical Missionaries.
