Blessed Maria Romero Meneses Religious (1902-1977)

Maria Romero Meneses was born to a wealthy family in Nicaragua, where her father was a government minister. The experience of a serious childhood illness prompted a religious vocation, and at the age of eighteen, inspired by the example Don Bosco, she joined the Salesian Sisters. In 1931 she was transferred to Costa Rica, where she spent the rest of her life.



The work of the Sisters focused mainly on educating the daughters of the upper class. But they also operated schools for the poor. Sr. Maria moved between both worlds, and soon she found her special mission in forming the social conscience of her wealthy students. She called them her *misioneritas* (little missionaries) and trained them to help her work among the poor—offering both material service as well as religious instruction. In time she founded her own schools, clinics, and soup kitchens, and even founded a model village, Centro San Jose, for poor families.

Her work was supported by the local bishop, a strong advocate of the social apostolate. She died on July 7, 1977 and was beatified in 2002—the first beatified saint of Central America.
