### Blessed Among Us James Alberione

**Founder, the Society of St. Paul (1884-1971)**

James Alberione was born to a farming family in northern Italy. After attending seminary in Alba he was ordained in 1907. He went on to earn a doctorate in theology and directed pastoral work at the seminary. On the last night of 1900 he spent the evening in prayer to discern how he might find a new way of serving the Church in a new century.

The answer came in 1913 when he took over a weekly Catholic magazine, *Gazette d'Alba*, thus beginning his lifelong work in the field of mass communication. In the following year he founded the Society of St. Paul (the Paulines), which was joined later by the Daughters of St. Paul, cofounded with Mother Thecla Merlo. Other congregations followed. Altogether the mission of the Pauline family focused on the apostolate of the Word—through bookstores, newspapers, magazines, and other publications.

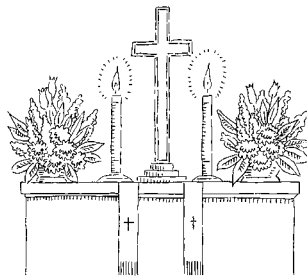
In 1969 Pope Paul, receiving representative Pauline priests and sisters in an audience, greeted Fr. Alberione: “Here he is, humble, silent, tireless, always vigilant, recollected in his thoughts, which run from prayer to action; always intent on scrutinizing the ‘signs of the times’, that is, the most creative way to reach souls. Our Fr. Alberione has given the Church new instruments with which to express herself.”

Fr. Alberione died on November 26, 1971. He was beatified in 2003. The work of his Pauline family continues in thirty countries around the globe.

### Jubilee of Mercy

#### Merciful Like The Father

In the Bull of Induction, "Misericordiae Vultus", for the Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy Pope Francis has asked that every local Church throughout the world open a "Holy Door of Mercy" in the Cathedral Church or another Church indicated by the Bishop of the Diocese. In addition, the local Bishop may name other Churches within his diocese to serve as pilgrimage places for the Jubilee of Mercy.

Bishop Olson has chosen Holy Redeemer to serve as a pilgrimage site for the coming Jubilee Year of Mercy. During the Jubilee Year of Mercy, those who visit any of the designated Churches may gain a plenary indulgence by meeting the usual conditions of Confession and reception of the Eucharist within a week before or after the pilgrimage, and while at the Church making a Profession of Faith and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father for the Church and the World.
