Blessed Among Us

Walter Burghardt

Jesuit (1914—2008)

Through years of teaching, scores of books, and his forty-four years as editor of *Theological Studies*, Walter Burghardt helped to invigorate the life of the American Catholic Church.

Perhaps his greatest passion lay in preaching: “wrestling with a Lord who reveals and conceals; God’s word issuing from these all too human lips.” (A university study named him—the only Catholic—among a list of the twelve best preachers in the U.S.) In every way he could, he tried to inspire this passion. “All too frequently,” he wrote, “our people are not confronted with a word that nourishes while it challenges, heals while it bruises.” An increasingly educated populace, he noted, “is no longer silent before homiletic pap and bromides.”

In 1991 he embarked on a crusade—“Preaching the Just Word” - to combine homiletics with a passion for social justice. “I agonize because in this land of milk and honey, one of every five children grows up beneath the poverty line-and our pulpits are silent.”

At the age of eighty-five, in a combination memoir/love letter to the Church entitled *Long Have I Loved You*, he traced the great figures and movements that had shaped him, and the challenges facing the Church. If he acknowledged his “reluctance in dying,” it was a reflection of his great joy in the life he had lived.

He died on February 16, 2008, at the age of ninety-three.

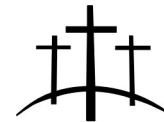
