**Soon-to-Be Saints  
Maria Elisabetta Hesselblad**

- 1870 Born on June 4 in Faglavik, Sweden.
- 1902: Received conditional baptism; converted to Catholicism from Lutheranism.
- 1906: Joined the Carmelites; received permission from Pope Pius X to wear the habit of the Order of the Most Holy Savior of St. Bridget, know as the Brigittines.
- 1911: Founded the Swedish branch of the Brigittines.
- 1957: Died on April 24.
- 2000: Beatified by Pope John Paul II on April 9.
- 2016: Will be canonized on June 5.
